We'll get started with cocktails at 6:00 pm, followed by dinner and a presentation at 7:00 pm. Roman S. Melnyk, DDS, MS will be presenting "LANAP" with the PerioLase MVP-7: Reflections and Results from a 12 Month Controlled Study in Private Practice. Two CE credits will be available.

### Course Synopsis:

Laser use, although gaining popularity in Dentistry, remains controversial and for good reason: there are few, if any published controlled studies supporting their use. Dr. Roman Melnyk will reflect on his six year experiences using the PerioLase MVP-7 Nd-YAG laser and give an overview on the different types of lasers used in dentistry today. He will also present the results of a 12 month comparative study between Laser Assisted New Attachment Procedure (LANAP) and scaling root planing controls.

Upon completion of the presentation, the attendee should have:

- a basic understanding of the different types of lasers used in dentistry
- which lasers are appropriate for which tissues
- an understanding of the LANAP protocol and its regenerative potential
- observed a number of documented cases of LANAP, of various post treatment durations
- an understanding of other applications of the PerioLase MVP-7 Nd-YAG laser
- been exposed to the results of one of the first controlled studies comparing LANAP and scaling root planing in "real world" applications
